

Hong Kong 2030+: Towards a Planning Vision and Strategy Transcending 2030 (“Hong Kong 2030+”)

The Development Bureau and the Planning Department of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region is currently undertaking a 6-month public engagement programme for Hong Kong 2030+, which is an updated territorial development strategy for Hong Kong.

In the context of a highly dense urban setting, where home space enhancement is constrained, public space is an important element to make Hong Kong a liveable, competitive and sustainable world city. Since October 2016, a series of events including public forums, workshops, briefings, knowledge sharing seminars, guided visits, school outreach programme and exhibitions (in collaboration with members of the public, academia, professionals, practitioners, government officials, etc) has been launched to engage the public on the future of public space in Hong Kong.
